- Plant trimmings
- Sawdust
- Seasonal pumpkins
- Shrubs
- Small pruning
- Sod (remove as much soil as possible)
- Stumps must not exceed 6" in diameter
- Succulents
- Tree trimmings cut to fit loosely in container
