Back-To-School!

Here are three R's to remember when shopping for back-to-school.

1. Reduce: Take Inventory

Make note of what you already have and create a shopping list of things you really need for the school year.

2. Reuse: Buy Green Supplies

Leave the plastic at home and consider investing in reusable lunch gear such as a stainless-steel lunch box, reusable utensils, BPA-free water bottles and food containers.

3. Recycle: Swap or Donate Clothing

Consider holding a gathering amongst your friends, family, or neighbors to do a clothes swap and donate the rest to your local donation center.



Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Please keep household hazardous waste, such as motor oil and batteries out of your garbage, recyclables, and green yard bins.

For the safe disposal of motor oil and used oil filters, give our Customer Service team a call.

Motor Oil & Filters

Request up to 3 free oil jugs and 3 filter bags by calling 650.568.9900.

Fill oil jug (or other empty container), tightly close the lid, and place it next to your blue recycle cart on collection day.

Batteries

Household batteries should be placed inside a clear and sealed plastic bag and placed on top of your blue recycle cart on collection day.



Planning Ahead!

Thanksgiving:

Reminder: GreenWaste does not collect on Thanksgiving Day. If your regular collection day falls on or after Thanksgiving, your collection will be delayed by one day.

Clean Up Event:
