Clean Up Day Reuse Guidelines

GreenWaste of Palo Alto accepts clean, gently used furniture for reuse through the residential Clean Up Day program.

To participate, set out your gently used furniture and label it with "Reuse" on your pre-scheduled Clean Up Day. Furniture that our partner donation organizations are seeking include:

- Chairs
- Coffee tables
- Couches
- Dining tables
- Dressers and bookshelves
- Loveseats
- Nightstand and end tables
- Small kitchen appliances (countertop only)

Reuse of items is highly dependent on what is acceptable to local reuse organizations and cannot be guaranteed by GreenWaste of Palo Alto. Our partner reuse organizations are seeking items that are clean and very gently used. Items for reuse cannot be antique, blemished, damaged, broken, stained, rusted, rotted, splintered, or missing pieces. If your item or furniture falls into these categories, it will not be reused. GreenWaste of Palo Alto drivers are knowledgeable of the reuse standards and will determine during collection what can be reused. Items deemed not reusable will be collected for recycling or disposal instead.

Additional items accepted for reuse include:

- Clothing and textiles
- Books
- CDs/DVDs (only commercial recordings in original cases and in resale condition; no personal recordings
