

Certified Compostable Bag Suppliers

As of July 1, 2020, businesses and residents who choose to use bags in their compost collection containers must use compostable plastic bags. For reference, a list of local compostable bag suppliers has been compiled below. To meet City requirements (5.20.030(d)), all compostable bags must be certified compostable by the Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) or meet ASTM D6400 or D66868 standards of composability.
