AB1826: Is Your Business in Compliance with This State Law?



ORGANICS RECYCLING LAW

State Law (Assembly Bill 1826) requires businesses to recycle organic waste.

WHO MUST COMPLY

On January 1, 2019 all businesses that subscribe to 4-cubic yards or more of solid waste services per week are required to participate in an organics recycling program.



How to determine if your business must comply?

GreenWaste Recovery provides free technical assistance to all commercial customers. Contact GreenWaste Recovery and ask to speak to an Outreach Coordinator who can help you determine the amount of solid waste being generated per week at your business. Or, calculate it yourself by multiplying the volume of your containers by the frequency of collection per week.

HOW TO COMPLY

Businesses can comply by taking one or a combination of the following actions:

1. **Subscribe** to GreenWaste Recovery service that specifically includes collection and recycling of organic waste. **Separate** your food waste into the food waste collection container provided by GreenWaste Recovery.
2. **Donate** leftover food that is fit for human consumption to a local food bank or non-profit charitable organization.

TYPES OF ORGANIC WASTE

Businesses must arrange for recycling services for the following types of organic waste:

- Pre- and post-consumer food scraps
- Certified compostable service ware products

Tips & Tricks to Keep Your Cart Cleaner, Longer



Trash, recycling, and food waste carts have a dirty job, so it's no wonder they need a good cleaning now and then. Practice these tips to keep your carts cleaner, for longer!

Bag your organics in certified compostable bags and tie the top before tossing into your food waste cart. Bagging food waste also makes it easier to transport them from the kitchen to the cart.

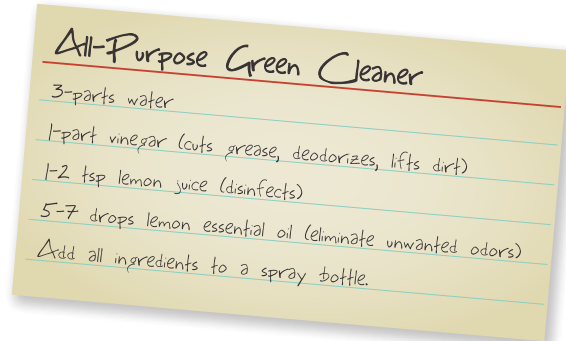
Store carts in a secure, cool, and ventilated location.

Bring your carts out for collection even when they are not full.

Sprinkle the bottom of your cart with baking soda to cut grease, deodorize, and help lift grime.

Rinse. When your cart needs a good rinsing, simply request a cart cleaning from GreenWaste Recovery (fees apply).

Spray down regularly with a DIY Green Cleaner. We've included a recipe. ►

GreenWaste Recovery will provide regular collection service on the following holidays:

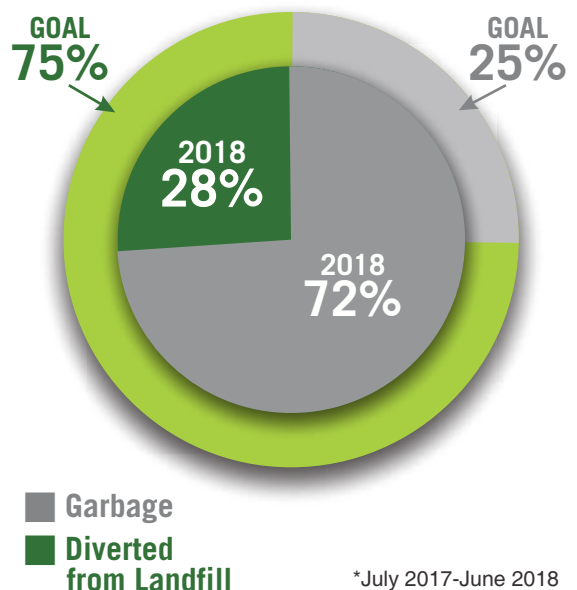
