Electronic Waste Collection

Many products we use in the normal course of business are not permitted in the garbage as they can pose hazards to our local environment (land, air, water, wildlife) and the people who pick up your garbage. These products require special care for disposal. To help protect you and your community, we offer an expanded recycling program that includes free small e-waste collection services to our customers, to prevent harmful metals and elements from contaminating our natural resources.

Many small e-Waste items are accepted in the recycling container.

Examples include:

- Small Appliances
- Calculators
- Cameras
- Computer Mice
- Inkjet Cartridges (bagged)
- Keyboards
- PDAs
- Phones

Remove any batteries and recycle those separately



MRWMD Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Facility



Small businesses, schools and non-profit organizations that are located on the Monterey Peninsula and generate less than 27 gallons or 220 lbs. of hazardous waste per month are classified as Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG). CESQGs may be eligible to drop-off items for a small fee at the HHW Facility at the Monterey Regional Waste Management District, two miles north of Marina. Items accepted include many household cleaning products, antifreeze, paints, solvents, pesticides, fertilizers, chemicals, fluorescent light bulbs, and more. Recycle Guidance: Shredded Paper!



RECYCLE SHREDDED PAPER

Shredded paper can be placed in your blue recycle container – but special steps must be taken. Put your shredded paper in a plastic or paper bag and tie, staple or tape the bag securely before placing the bag in your recycle cart. Securely bagging the shredded paper is an important step, preventing the little bits of paper from flying away and littering your community.

OTHER SHREDDED ITEMS

Please remember that shredded credit cards, CDs and DVDs cannot go in with the shredded paper for recycling. These materials should be shredded separately and placed in your garbage bin.
