Cardboard Overload!

Are you dealing with excess cardboard and don't have enough space in your recyclables container? Not to worry, we have solutions for you! First, make sure your cardboard is broken down and flattened to fit neatly inside the container. Unbroken boxes take up unnecessary space. If you still have extra cardboard flatten the cardboard, tie it in a secured bundle no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' and place it next to your regularly serviced container. Additional charges apply, so call Customer Service to schedule. Please do not place loose cardboard out for pick up. Loose cardboard is difficult to collect, creates roadside litter and will not be collected.



Do you regularly have extra cardboard? It may be time to rethink your recyclables service collection level. Contact our Customer Service Department to schedule an on-site visit with our Outreach Team. An Outreach Coordinator will help you determine the solution that works best for your business.

New Mattress Recycling Program

The Monterey Regional Waste Management District now offers free or reduced disposal on mattresses and boxsprings to residents and businesses within the Monterey Peninsula.

Illegal dumping of mattresses and boxsprings have been an issue within communities across the Monterey Peninsula. Not only are they unsightly and potential health hazards, but they cost the cities a great deal of money to collect and dispose of when illegally dumped. A new state program has been developed in an effort to help provide cost effective ways for residents and business owners to properly dispose of these items. Effective January 1, 2016 the California Mattress Recycling Program has established a producer responsibility program to cover the cost of mattress recycling. Consumers now pay a recycling fee when purchasing a new mattress, which helps fund proper recycling of old mattresses and box springs.

The following options are now available at Monterey Regional Waste Management District in Marina:

Residents: Free drop off of 5 or fewer mattresses or boxsprings from residents only.

Commercial/Businesses: Charge of \$5.00 for each drop off of a mattress and box spring.
