Why the Changes to Local Recycling Programs?

The recycling landscape has changed significantly in 2018. China's decision to place an embargo on the import of some recyclable materials has left U.S. recyclers scrambling to find a destination to recycle materials such as plastic bags (film plastics), Styrofoam and more.

Locally, recyclable materials collected by GreenWaste are processed by the Monterey Regional Waste Management District (District) at their Materials Recovery Facility. To help ensure that the recyclables processed at the District are as clean as possible and can be manufactured into new products, significant changes to the materials accepted in the recycling program have occurred. Film plastics, Styrofoam, bagged textiles, small electronic waste and appliances have been removed from the list of materials that can go in the recycling container.

GreenWaste has also worked with the District and other haulers in the county to develop a new website resource: www.WhatGoesWhere.info. The website features a search bar where you can easily check if an item is recyclable in your city. You can also download the What Goes Where app to use on your smart phone. Our goal is to make the local recycling program easy to understand and sustainable by collecting materials that are readily recyclable. If you are not sure if an item you are about to toss in the recycling container can in fact be recycled, consult the What Goes Where website or call our customer service center at 831-920-6707 for guidance.

Mandatory recycling of organic waste is the next step toward achieving California's aggressive recycling and greenhouse gas emission goals. As of January 1, 2019 businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of commercial solid waste per week must recycle their organic waste by law.
