No Collection on Thanksgiving: GreenWaste of Palo Alto will be closed on Thanksgiving Day. If your regular collection day falls on Thanksgiving Day, your collection day will be moved to Friday (November 29). Customers with collection day on Friday will be serviced on Saturday (November 30).

BUSINESS WASTE REDUCTION:

Businesses are making positive impacts in the community and globally by incorporating waste reduction practices — yours can too! Your business plays a crucial role in determining how Palo Alto stands up to climate change.



Check out the new Business Waste Reduction webpage for guidance on how to incorporate waste reduction practices in your business model to cut out greenhouse gases and create a more sustainable future. Some of the waste reduction practices include:

- · Conduct a zero waste assessment
 - Survey your business and assess each area where waste is created and disposed of to better identify areas of
 improvement. Ensure proper waste stations are set up and your business is meeting other City requirements.
 Contact GreenWaste of Palo Alto to make sure the services you subscribed are "right-sized"
- · Switch to reusable items
 - Review and identify the single-use items your business is purchasing. Work towards replacing them with reusable items such as reusable coffee mugs and encouraging the use of reusable items by installing a sink or dishwasher in

the breakroom

- · Ask vendors to take back packaging
 - · Examine existing purchasing patterns to identify shipments that create the most waste. Communicate your commitment to sustainability with your vendors and request they adjust their shipping methods to reduce the waste produced or take back their packaging for reuse or recycling

How to schedule your Clean Up Day?

- · Businesses receive one free Clean Up Day for the collection of up to four bulky items each calendar year
- · Contact our customer service team at least one week in advance to schedule

- · One of GreenWaste of Palo Alto's Environmental Outreach Coordinators will then connect with you to finalize scheduling the service

How do I dispose of TVs or Computer monitors?

· TVs or computer monitors cannot be placed in any of the curbside containers but can be collected as a bulky item either for a service fee or through the Clean Up Day. Contact GreenWaste to schedule the service, place



Ordering items online means more cardboard boxes in the recycle containers. To manage all the extra cardboard, ensure boxes are properly prepared for your recycling collection:

- · Remove all packing material and place it in the correct container
- · Clean film plastic should be bagged with other film plastic and placed in your blue recycle container. Styrofoam goes in your black or tan landfill container
- · FLATTEN cardboard and place it inside your blue recycle container loosely with other recyclables. Tape, labels, and staples on boxes are okay

Some businesses may qualify to receive a few free internal compost and recycle containers to help establish waste stations and meet City requirements

How do I dispose of larger bulky items such as cabinets or conference tables?

For larger cabinets and conference tables, the items must be less than 200lbs or broken down into smaller bundles if possible. Each bundle will count as one bulky item. Larger items must be placed along the curb or outside in an easily accessible location on the property the night prior to collection. If you're unsure if the item is too large, send a photo to GreenWaste Customer Service for an assessment.
