## Keep TWW Out of the Trash



## Q: What is Treated Wood Waste (TWW)?

**A:** Wood that is treated with chemical preservatives to protect against insects, fungi and other microorganisms. These chemicals include arsenic, chromium, copper, pentachlorophenol and creosote.

## Q: How do I know if it's TWW?

A: TWW can often be visually distinguished by its appearance. Look for:

- Treated wood end tag
- Manufacturer stamp codes
- Indentations on surface
- Odor

- When cut, staining visible around perimeter only
- Discoloration (e.g. green or dark brown)

## Q: How do I properly dispose of TWW?
