Food and yard waste in landfills emit 20% of the state's methane, a climate super pollutant 84 times more potent than carbon dioxide. In compliance with new statewide regulation (SB1383), the City of Capitola is now required to include food scraps to current yard waste collection services. All food scraps and yard waste need to be placed in your green organics container.

What goes in the GREEN bin?

Leaves, meat bones, food scraps, eggshells, wood lumber, yard clippings, coffee grounds and paper filters.

GreenWaste needs your help keeping the recycling clean. Avoid contaminating the items in your recycling container to ensure they will be successfully recycled, not landfilled. Empty and scrape contents, and allow to dry before placing items into the recycling container.

Take advantage of this curbside service provided by GreenWaste Recovery to help you with your Spring Cleaning!

Dispose of one bulky item (like furniture, appliances, etc.) and up to seven bags or cans of garbage, not to exceed 50 lbs. each. All items must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your regular day of service. Household hazardous waste will not be accepted. For bulky items, please call GreenWaste Recovery to schedule a pick up at 831.768.9505.

Report Illegal Dumping
