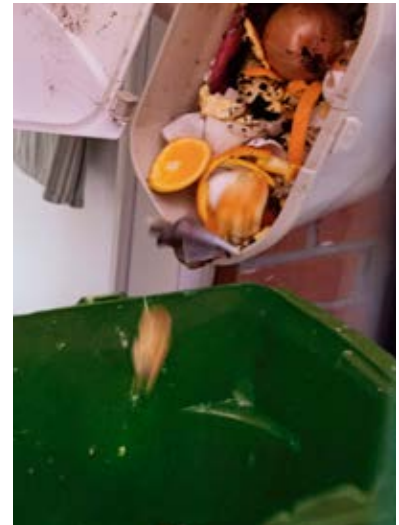
Reducing Food Waste

According to Senate Bill 1383, California businesses are required to divert organic material from the landfill. Properly sorting food and organic waste to keep it out of the landfill benefits the planet by reducing methane emissions and creating nutrient-rich compost. Adding an organics container to your services can reduce your waste management costs. Here are some tips you can implement immediately to benefit your business, and the environment:

Make It Easy: Keep labeled organics waste containers where organic waste is often disposed like dining areas and kitchens.

Create Less Waste: Frequently check your pantry and refrigerator, and use food before it expires. Consider donating excess food to local food banks or food kitchens.

BPI-certified compostable plastics are the only compostable plastics allowed in your city's commercial organics stream. If you have any questions regarding BPI compostable products, consult your vendor before purchasing.



SB 1383 Requirement Update

California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) requires Californian businesses to subscribe to and utilize recycling and organics collection services, unless you have received a waiver from your city. Your city is proactive in monitoring compliance and is issuing violation notices and implementing penalties to those who do not follow these regulations.

-  Keep carts in a cool, dry place out of the sun.
-  Freeze scraps in a container and empty them into the cart the night before service.
