Prevent Battery Fires

Batteries and electronics with batteries do not belong in any of your carts or bins. They are considered household hazardous waste and can cause fires in collection vehicles and at the Material Recovery Facility where they are sorted.

Follow these steps to dispose batteries safely:

- 1) Collect your household batteries, including AA, AAA, C, D, 6-volt, 9-volt, camera batteries, nickel cadmium, and lithium ion.
- 2) Contact ReGen Monterey at **831.384.5313** or regenmonterey.org for information or check drop-off location and hours online.
- 3) Drop off your batteries for safe disposal and recycling at 14207 Del Monte Blvd or participating hardware stores.



Free Bulky Item Collection

Cleaning or decluttering for the spring? Property managers or authorized users can request up to 3 bulky item pickups per year at no additional charge. Each pickup can include the following:

- 2 cubic yards of reusable materials (boxed or bagged)
- 5 electronic items (televisions, laptops, monitors, etc.)
- 2 appliances or bulky items. Appliances containing Freon (i.e. refrigerators, air conditioning units) count as 2 bulky items.

Additional eligible items or collection events may be scheduled for an additional charge. GreenWaste does not collect hazardous waste, auto parts, construction materials or commercial waste. Contact us at **831.920.6707** to schedule your pickup!

Cardboard Breakdown

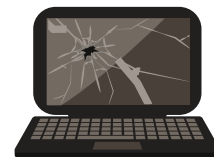
Remember to flatten your cardboard before placing it in your blue recycling container(s) to preserve space! As a reminder, cardboard must be unwaxed, clean, and dry to be recyclable. Lids of bins and carts must be completely closed on service day or additional service charges may be applied to your account. Keeping the lids closed reduces litter and ensures safe collection for our drivers. If your recyclables are often overflowing, request an Environmental Outreach Coordinator at **831.920.6707** to help rightsize your services.
