Prevent Battery Fires

Household batteries and car batteries are considered hazardous waste. They can cause fires in collection vehicles or harm employees at the Materials Recovery Facility who manually sort your recyclables. Batteries and electronics should not be placed inside any of your carts.

Safely dispose of your batteries by:

- Taping the top of 9-volt rectangular batteries and 6-volt square-base batteries.
- Placing your household batteries, including AA, AAA, C, D, 6-volt, 9-volt, camera batteries, nickel cadmium, and lithium ion in a clear bag on top of your recycling cart (button-cell coin-shaped batteries are not accepted).

Residents may schedule collection of up to one car battery per week, on the normal collection day, at no additional charge. Call customer service at **831.920.6707** to schedule.



Free Bulky Item Collection

Cleaning or decluttering for the spring? Residents can request up to 3 bulky item curbside collections per year at no additional charge. Each curbside collection can include the following:

- 2 cubic yards of reusable materials (boxed or bagged)
- 5 electronic items (televisions, laptops, monitors, etc.)
- 2 appliances or bulky items. Appliances containing Freon (i.e. refrigerators, air conditioning units) count as 2 bulky items.

Additional eligible items or collection events may be scheduled for an additional charge. GreenWaste does not collect hazardous waste, auto parts, construction materials or commercial waste. Contact us at **831.920.6707** to schedule your pickup!

Cardboard Breakdown

On your regular collection day, residents can place extra flattened cardboard in secured bundles no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' next to their blue recycling cart. No annual stickers are needed for extra cardboard, and it will be collected at no additional charge. Cardboard will not be collected if it is loose, so make sure to secure it with tape, twine, or rope to prevent litter.

If your recycle cart is often overflowing, you may be able to increase the size of your cart at no additional charge, or add a second recycling cart for a charge. Reach out to our customer service team at **831.920.6707** with any questions. We're here to help!
