Reducing Food Waste

When food and yard waste decomposes in a landfill, it produces methane, a more potent greenhouse gas than carbon dioxide. By composting this material instead, we significantly reduce methane emissions and create a nutrient-rich compost that supports our soils.

Here are tips you can implement today:

Make It Easy: Keep labeled organics waste containers where organic waste is often disposed, like your kitchen.

Keep It Clean: Visit GreenWaste.com for instructions on how to sort your waste effectively.

Create Less Waste: Frequently check your pantry and refrigerator, and use food before it expires. Consider donating excess food to local food banks or food kitchens.






Put Compostable Ware in Your Gray Cart

Compostable cups, plates, bags, and other compostable plastics are not allowed in your green organics cart. These items belong in your gray trash cart.

Getting Into Organics

Did you know something as simple as using your organics container can combat climate change? Using your organics container more often doesn't have to mean more mess.

To keep your organics containers fresh and clean:

-  Sprinkle baking soda on the bottom of your green organics carts.
-  Keep carts in a cool, dry place out of the sun.
-  Freeze scraps in a container and empty them into the cart the night before service.

Since 2022, more than 75 percent of GreenWaste customers in Monterey County participate in organic diversion!

SB 1383 Requirement Update

California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) requires that everyone, including residents, divert food scraps from landfills. This means that all residential homes must subscribe to waste, recycling, and organics collection services through GreenWaste. The city has been issuing notices of violations since last year and will now start imposing penalties on those who do not comply.

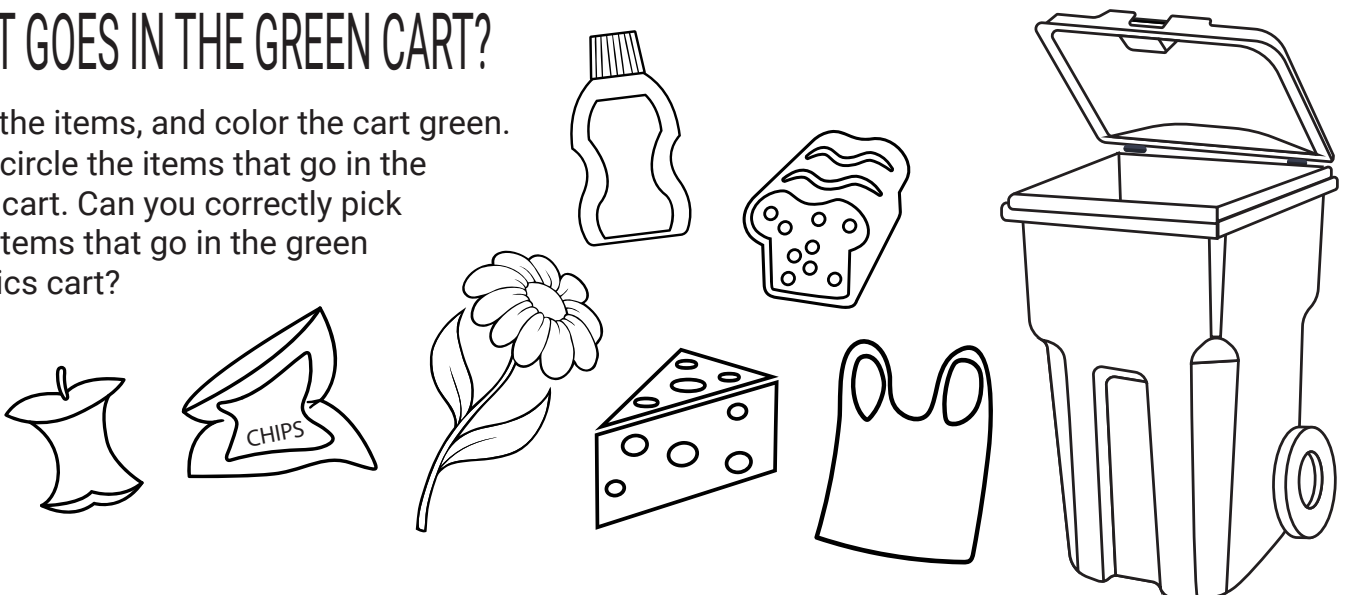
